I am writing in response to your email dated 8<sup>th</sup> August 2019 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding spend on Coca Cola.

On the same day we contacted you via email as we required clarification on the following:  
Q2 what you are expecting as part of a breakdown as this would normally be a rating only.

On the same day you replied via email they following:

*"I mean if there are multiple food outlets/kitchens in your hospital that have different ratings, I would like information about all of them".*

As of 1<sup>st</sup> November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

**Q1 How much did the Trust spend on Coca Cola in the last 12 months? What is this as part of the Trust's total supply budget?**

A1 Information is not held for the Royal Stoke University Hospital as this service is provided by a Private Financed Initiative (PFI) contract.

County Hospital: Nightingales Restaurant.

Total coca cola products:

- April 2018 to March 2019 = 5472 Bottles
- April 2019 to 5<sup>th</sup> August 2019 = 1248 Bottles
- Average cost per bottle 60p

**Q2 What is the food hygiene rating of your hospital food outlets/ kitchens? I would like a detailed breakdown of this information.**

A2 Information not held for the Royal Stoke University Hospital as this service is provided by a Private Financed Initiative (PFI) contract. County Hospital, see attached document.


