I am writing in response to your email dated 11th June 2018 (received into our office 12th June) requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding workload and annual caseload statistics.

On 13th June 2018 we contacted you via email as we required clarification on Q2.

On the same day you replied via email with the following:
"Thanks for your kind reply. Regarding your questions:

- *Number of Fracture Neck of Femur spells: I meant Number of Patients admitted with primary diagnosis of fracture neck of femur per year (patients admitted with following fracture neck of Femur)*
- *Number of Joint Replacement spells: I meant All Joint replacements.*

I hope this clarifies any ambiguity. Thanks for your kind help and prompt response".


