I am writing in response to your email dated 13th June 2018 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding product catalogue of un-licensed medicines.

On 14th June 2018 you contacted us via email with further the below clarification on your question;

“Much appreciated – many thanks for your help, I am looking for all the injectable specials manufactured at NHS units or for NHS for e.g. at Baxter, Novalabs, Qualasept Pharmaxo. The non-sterile specials are available in public domain and in drug tariff – I am looking for similar information for injectable specials either manufactured in UK or imported into UK”

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

Q1 Under Freedom of Information; I would like to request your product catalogue of un-licensed medicines manufactured at NHS manufacturing units

A1 Please see attached documents, however please note:

At UHNM Pharmacy all aseptic products are made under the Medicines and Healthcare Products Regulatory Agency (MHRA) Manufacturer’s ‘Specials’ Licence, the three attachments detail a full list of products

Key:

Drug name	self-explanatory
Product category	N/A = not made at the site
Who supplies	in-house (this facility) – made by UHNM N/A not made at UHNM Non-NHS commercial company = products bought in for use at UHNM

We also do a range of bespoke parenteral nutrition products for adults, paediatrics and neonates.

UHNM NHS Trust is a public sector body and governed by EU law. FOI requestors should note that any new Trust requirements over the EU threshold will be subject to these regulations and will be advertised for open competition accordingly.
