I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 9th November 2022 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding elective surgery

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

Q1 Please could I request the following information under the Freedom of Information Act on waiting times and the waiting list for elective surgery at your Trust?

How many patients are currently on the waiting list for elective surgery? Of these, how many have been waiting for i) more than 6 months ii) more than twelve months c) more than eighteen months.

A1 Data as at the 8th November (data used Admission method – Elective – Waiting List & Elective - Booked)

i) More than 6 months – we have used the weeks waited cohort 26+ weeks waited = 7494

ii) More than twelve months - we have used the weeks waited cohort 52+ weeks waited = 3039

 iii) More than eighteen months – we have used the weeks waited cohort 78+ weeks waited = 675

Q2 What was the average wait for elective surgery in the past three financial years i) 2021/22 ii) 2020/21 and iii) 2019/20?

A2 Data as at the 8th November (we looked at activity undertaken for admission method Elective and looked at the days between the decision to admit date and admission date)

Q3 Currently, what are the five longest waits for elective surgery at your Trust?

If possible, please could i have this information broken down by the type of elective procedure e.g. a) knee replacement b) hip replacement and c) cataract?

Please can you provide the information in electronic format by email – ideally a single spread sheet if possible?

- A3 Data as at the 8th November the below are the 5 longest waits
 - 158 weeks waiting V388 primary fusion of other joint of spine other specified
 - 143 weeks waiting A577 injection of therapeutic substance around spinal nerve root
 - 142 weeks waiting B279 total excision of breast unspecified
 - 128 weeks waiting F038 correction of deformity of lip other specified
 - 125 weeks waiting Y542 harvest of nerve of head
