I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 18th October 2022 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding Payroll FOI.

As of 1<sup>st</sup> November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

Q1 I would like to submit an FOI request regarding the annual cost of running the UHNM Payroll department

How many people's payrolls they process on average per month.

I would also like to know how many they processed in the month of September 2022 through September 2021,

- A1 The cost of combined pensions and payroll service (outsourced to RWT) £619k pa approx. with 14,950 payslips per month
- I would also like to know how many shifts have been filled using external locums in the last 12 months, and what the total £ cost of external locums over this period has been.
- A2 The cost of external doctors was £12,165,569, 16,527 shifts

AHP/HSS was £1,587,046, 6827 shifts
