I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2022 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding Digital / Data Team Structures

As of 1<sup>st</sup> November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

Q1 Please can you provide me with a copy of your Digital / Data Teams structures (including the establishment WTE for each post)?

If they are not included in your Digital / Data functions then please also include the structures for the following teams:

Clinical Informatics Health Records / Records Management Subject Access Information Governance Data Quality 18 Weeks / RTT Validation Performance Management

A1 Not all of the information you have requested is recorded in the format you are requiring for all the areas, and would therefore require us to create a new document to provide this. The FOI Act covers information *held* by the Trust, and we are not obliged to create new information in order to answer an FOI request, however, where there is 'no structure chart' we have provided the WTE. See below:

Clinical Informatics = 15.25 WTE + 1 Head of Information Services Health Records / Records Management = attached Subject Access = attached Information Governance = attached Data Quality = 9 WTE + 1 WTE Head of DQ & Coding







18 Weeks / RTT Validation = attached Performance Management = 3 WTE
