I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 25th January 2023 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding hospital catering

As of 1<sup>st</sup> November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

- Q1 Using Freedom of Information rules, I request the following information please
  - The names of all companies under contract to provide hospital catering within your iurisdiction
- A1 County Hospital is In house catering. Royal Stoke The Catering is provided by the Trust's PFI Partner so the information is not held by the Trust
- Q2 Specifically, if applicable, the names of all companies contracted to supply meat products for use in hospitals within your jurisdiction
- A2 County Hospital meat products are supplied by Midland Food. Royal Stoke, The Catering is provided by the Trust's PFI Partner so the information is not held by the Trust
- Q3 The origin of beef and poultry meat procured by these companies for use in hospitals within your jurisdiction
  - Please supply any information in spread sheet format
- A3 County Hospital British. Red Tractor and Soil Association accredited. Royal Stoke The Catering is provided by the Trust's PFI Partner so the information is not held by the Trust
