I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 8th February 2023 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding Maternity services

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

In accordance with the Freedom of Information Act, I would be grateful if you could comply with the following request. Could you provide the following information?

What is the average age of foetal monitoring devices/equipment in each birthing centre?

- A1 See attached spread sheet: note, 200K has been sourced to replace any CTG monitors as they require it. (we cannot be specific with numbers but we will replace the oldest first)
- Q2 What is the oldest foetal monitoring device/equipment in the Trust?
- A2 15 years
- Q3 How many midwives are employed in each birthing centre? Please provide this information for the last five calendar years 2022, 2021, 2020, 2019 and 2018
- A3 The below is the contracted Whole Time Equivalent (WTE) of Midwives employed by the Trust in the December of each of the years requested.

2021 - 240.26 WTE

2022 - 239.21 WTE
