I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 4th July 2023 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding Chitin/Chitosan

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites - Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

I am writing to University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust to request information Q1 under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. I am outlining my query as specifically as possible to assist you with this request. I would like to know:
