I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 8<sup>th</sup> June 2023 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding diagnostic tests

As of 1<sup>st</sup> November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

## Q1 Which specific procedures are conducted by Healthcare Professionals within?

- a) The diagnostic tests available in the Trust's Community Diagnostic Centres

## A1 See below;

- a) The Trust does not have a live community diagnostic centre. A recently developed surgical hub has been commissioned at the County Hospital Site
- b) The Trust aligns surgical capacity to the needs of the patient through a variety of different locations across acute hospital sites. At the recently developed hub at the County hospital site, there are a variety of day case, OPPROC and diagnostic procedures carried out across multiple specialities including orthopaedic surgery, urology, pain management, gynaecology, plastics surgery and GI services
