
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I will enter Royal Stoke Hospital through the main entrance doors.



I will then follow the signs to Child Assessment Unit (Ward 216)



Hospital

The doctor will tell me if I have to stay in hospital or can go home.



Home



The nurse may put a plastic tube with a needle called a cannula in my hand to give me medicine.



If the doctor thinks I have a problem with my bones, they will send me to have an X ray.



My parent or carer will use the intercom to speak to a member of staff to open the door



My parent or carers will give my details to the receptionist



I will stay in the waiting room until the nurse calls my name. My parents can come with me.



The nurse will speak to me and my parent or carer about why I have come to Children's Assessment Unit



l will have my blood pressure taken



My temperature will be taken using an ear thermometer



Oxygen levels in my blood, will be checked using a plastic clip on my finger.
