I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 3rd August 2023 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding Transplant training and Transplant training

On 4th August 2023 we contacted you with the following:

UHNM has received several requests that are asking for similar information that are from the same person/company; therefore we are contacting you to inform you that under section 12 of the FOI Act we were aggregating these requests on Organ transplantation and Transplant training

Your new reference number for both is 287-2324

The section 12 exemption states:

The authority can combine related requests received within a period of 60 consecutive days from:

- The same person or
- People who appear to be acting in concert or in pursuance of a campaign.
