I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 29th June 2023 sent to one of our consultants requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding Scrotal Exploration Data.

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

Q1 The data collection form is very short and it won't take more than a few minutes to complete once you have access to the necessary data. Data on the number of scrotal explorations performed at your hospital can often be found via CEPOD / theatre coding and staff.
