I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 13th September 2023 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding pest control

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

Q1 I am writing to request information under the Freedom of Information Act regarding pest control measures at your NHS Trust's hospital sites over the last five years.

Specifically, I would like to obtain the following data:

The total number of times exterminators or pest control services were called at each hospital between 2018 and 2023 to date.

A1 The following information relates to County Hospital only. The Royal Stoke University Hospital is managed by a PFI, and therefore information is not held

- A3 The pest control contract covers call outs and routine visits and it is not possible to break this down.
