I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 20th July 2023 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding visitation policies.

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

Q1 Please find below a freedom of information request for your Trust.

Did your Trust alter or update its visitor policy in response to Covid-19, yes or no?

- a. If yes, what changes were introduced?
- b. If yes, are any of those policies still in place?
- i. If yes, which of those policies are still in place?

- 1. Yes
 - a. The Trust followed NHS England guidance regarding visiting healthcare inpatient settings during the COVID-19 Pandemic as it was issued and amended between 2020 and 2022, which advised initially on restrictions to introduce and later on how to manage visiting in a very careful and Covid secure way.
 - b. no
- Q2 Does the Trust currently have any visitation policies that:
 - a. Would prevent a patient from receiving a visitor?
 - i. If yes, in what wards or circumstances does this apply?
 - ii. If yes, were these restrictions in place before March 2020?
 - b. Set a restriction on the number of different people able to visit a patient during their stay







i. If yes, in what wards or circumstances would the number of different people visiting a patient be restricted?

- ii. If yes, how many different people do these restrictions permit as visitors?
- iii. If yes, were these restrictions in place before March 2020?
