I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 11th October 2023 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding car parking.

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore, the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

Q1 Through the Freedom of Information Act, I make the following request relating to hospital parking charges.

I request the total amount of car parking revenue collected by University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust across Royal Stoke University Hospital and County Hospital, in Stafford. I request the information for the 2022/23 financial year.
