I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 16th October 2023 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding blood cultures

As of 1<sup>st</sup> November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

- Q1 This is a FOI request relating to the microbiology laboratory service and blood cultures. data should be easily available by interrogating laboratory information systems or from audit reports.
  - 1. Please table the hospitals or other acute sites currently submitting blood cultures and for each site-
  - i) Are blood cultures incubated and/or processed on site or sent to a microbiology laboratory off site?
  - ii) If incubated or processed off site, what is the distance in miles between the site and the offsite laboratory?

## **Comments:**

Microbiology service operates 24/7 from RSUH site (commenced Nov 2021). Hourly transport operates during 7am-8pm and with 2 hourly overnight collections. On-going projects with IP teams and Sepsis Groups to encourage wards to treat blood cultures as urgent and to send specimens to the collection points to improve transit times.

Mid-Cheshire NHS Trust: Approx.260000

- Q4 What was the total expenditure on laboratory services (directorate of pathology) as a percentage of total Trust expenditure in the year 2022/23?
- A4 3.7% for UHNM

- A5 No formal policy for when to take blood cultures as this is a clinical decision. Sepsis 6 pathway is used and information about blood culture bottle types and fill volumes available on Pathology Website
