I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 17th November 2023 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding pathology services

As of 1<sup>st</sup> November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

I made a Freedom of Information Request to East Cheshire NHS Trust. As you can see from their response below, they have indicated that University Hospitals of North Midlands Trust hold the data requested (presumably because you conduct their blood tests) and that I should redirect the request to you.

I'm therefore making the following information request to your Trust:

- 1. How many of the following tests were ordered by clinicians/staff for in-patients or out patients\* being seen by East Chesire NHS Trust maternity services during the last 12 month period for which data is available. Please specify what period is being reported on.
  - a) ANA (anti-nuclear antibody) test.
  - (b) ENA (extractable nuclear antigen) panel.
  - (c) Full Blood Count (FBC).
  - (d) Anti-phospholipid anti-body test(s) (for lupus anticoagulant, anticardiolipin antibody, anti-beta 2 glycoprotein or any other antiphospholipid antibodies).
    \*By "patients" I mean the women patients, not their babies.
- A1 See below: (Macclesfield DGH Maternity Services) \*By "patients" I mean the women patients, not their babies.
  - a) ANA (anti-nuclear antibody) test: 8
  - (b) ENA (extractable nuclear antigen) panel: 7
  - (c) Full Blood Count (FBC): 4114
  - (d) Anti-phospholipid anti-body test(s) (for lupus anticoagulant, anticardiolipin antibody, anti-beta 2 glycoprotein or any other antiphospholipid antibodies): 10
