I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 19th October 2023 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding IT systems and applications

As of 1<sup>st</sup> November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.
