UHNM has received several requests that are asking for similar information that are from the same person/company, therefore we are contacting you to inform you that under section 12 of the FOI Act we were aggregating these requests on cancer and rickets

Your new reference number for both is 463-2324

The section 12 exemption states:

The authority can combine related requests received within a period of 60 consecutive days from:

- The same person or
- People who appear to be acting in concert or in pursuance of a campaign.

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

How many patients are currently on your Trust's waiting list for a cancer diagnostic test?

- Q2 How many patients were on your Trust's waiting list for a cancer diagnostic test 12 months ago?
- A2 1515 patients waiting for a diagnostic test as of 01.12.2022







- Q3 What is the longest time a patient has had to wait for a cancer diagnostic test in the last 12 months?
- A3 Data is not available
- Q4 How many cancer diagnostic tests have been cancelled by your Trust for non-clinical reasons in the last 12 months?
- A4 Data is not available
- Q5 What is the highest number of times a cancer diagnostic test for one patient has been cancelled by your Trust for non-clinical reasons in the last 12 months
- A5 Data is not available

Request #2

- Q1 Please can I request the following information under the Freedom of Information Act on rickets and scurvy at your Trust.
 - How many patients has Your Trust treated for scurvy in each of the years a) 2019, b) 2020, c) 2021, d) 2022, e) 2023
- A1 Information not held (ICD10 coding E550 Rickets and E54 Vitamin C Deficiency and we do not have any patients)
- Q2 How many patients has your Trust treated for rickets in each of the years a) 2019, b) 2020, c) 2021, d) 2022, e) 2023
- A2 As answer 1
