I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 22nd June 2023 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding parental nutrition days.

On 27th June we contacted you via email as we require clarification on the specific time period please can you advise from what date require the information to begin and end at? In addition, Parental nutrition as in feeding parents within the hospital setting? Or Parenteral Nutrition?

On the same day you replied via email with:

'Thank you for getting back to me. To clarify I am requesting how many patients are using total parental nutrition through intravenous access per year. January to January 2021-2022.'

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

- Under the freedom of information act I am requesting any academic information regarding how many parental nutrition days that are conducted under the Trust per annum, if it's possible to get an estimated figure from yourselves that would really aid my research into my chosen hypothesis.
