I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 4th December 2023 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding Parkinson's

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

- Q1 How many people have been newly diagnosed with Parkinson's and prescribed Parkinson's medications since January 2022 at a Neurology clinic provided by University Hospitals of North Midlands?
- A1 1156
- Q2 Of the total number of people newly diagnosed and prescribed Parkinson's medication how many were registered to GP's in mid and south Cheshire (full list of GP surgeries provided below). We do not require the numbers per surgery, only the total number.

- A2 The Number with activity under a newly diagnosed nurse clinic code and under one of the listed GP Surgeries = 260
- Q3 Of those newly diagnosed and prescribed Parkinson's medications, how many have been offered a follow up appointment within 6 months (of the appointment where they were prescribed Parkinson's medications) with a Nurse or a Consultant?
- A3 I can neither confirm nor deny whether the information you have requested is held by the Trust in its entirety. This is because the information requested in this question is not held centrally, but may be recorded in health records. In order to confirm whether this information is held we would therefore have to individually access all health records within the Trust and extract the information where it is present. We therefore estimate that complying with your request is exempt under section 12 of the FOI Act: *cost of compliance is excessive*. The section 12 exemption applies when it is estimated a request will take in excess of 18 hours to complete. We estimate that accessing and reviewing all health records and then extracting relevant information would take longer than the 18 hours allowed for. In addition to the section 12 exemption the Trust is also applying section 14 (1) exemption: *oppressive burden on the authority*

Q4 Where the follow up appointment was with a Consultant, how many appointments were with locum Consultants?

A4 I can neither confirm nor deny whether the information you have requested is held by the Trust in its entirety. In order to confirm whether this information is held we would therefore have to individually access all health records within the Trust and extract the information where it is present.
