I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 16th December 2023 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding self discharges

As of 1st November 2014, University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore, the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

I am a student nurse at Keele University and currently doing a business report trying to improve healthcare innovations. My topic is regarding imputing more day rooms in wards to allow people to socialise more. The information I require is.

How many day/social rooms are there which are situated on the ward, out of all the wards in UHNM (including County hospital)?

- A1 25 day/social rooms are there are situated on wards in UHNM (including county hospital)
- Q2 On average how many self-discharges are made across the Trust over a year or months AND if you could please specify the different age categories of the people making these self-discharges?
- A2 For the period 01/01/2023 to 31/12/2023 this is the total number of self-discharges 3300.
