I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 15th March 2024 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding North Bristol Model

As of 1<sup>st</sup> November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

On 8th September 2022 there was a Quarterly System Review Meeting of the Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent (SSOT) system, chaired by Dale Bywater, Regional Director.
