I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 22nd February 2023 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding Management of Corporate Property and Asset Information

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

Q1 I would be most grateful if you would provide me, under the Freedom of Information Act, the following information regarding your facilities management approach:

If any, which software solution(s) are used to manage your corporate property/assets, ownerships and occupations, lease agreements and facilities management (CAFM), and who are your current provider(s)?

A1 MICAD is used to manager the Trust property portfolio and CAFM solution.

Q2 What is the start date and duration of the contract(s)?

A2 The current contract is 6th March 2023 to 5th March 2024.

Q3 Is there an extension clause in the contract(s) and, if so, the duration of the extension?

A3 No extension clause in the contract

Q4 Has a decision been made yet on whether the contract(s) will be extended or renewed?

A4 No decision has been made, but the implementation of any new software would take over 12-18 months to complete. So an extension to the existing contract would be required.

Q5 What is the annual value of the contract(s)?

A5 Annual value is £69,054.60 incl. VAT for all the MICAD Software elements.

Q6 What is the total contract value of each contract?

A6 Contract value is £69,054.60 incl. VAT

Q7 How was the contract(s) procured, e.g., framework/tender?

A7 Direct Award back in 2014..

Q8 Who is the senior officer responsible for these systems?

A8 Mark Horwell* and Alex Luffman * are the responsible officers for the software.
