



RAISING CONCERNS

If you are a medical student or doctor in training and have serious concerns that might affect patient safety or that is about unprofessional behaviour, either clinically or in your clinical teaching, you should do one or more of the following:

Speak to your peers and see if they agree with you that the concerns that you have are genuine

Speak to the Hospital Dean/Deputy Dean
