## Dear

I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 22nd September 2022(received into our office 23rd September) requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding clinical negligence claims in the maternity sector.

As of 1<sup>st</sup> November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

Q1 Please provide me with an annual breakdown of the total number successful clinical negligence claims made against the Trust in the maternity sector and the total value of the damages paid out in the maternity sector, broken down at a site-level.

I am specifically requesting the information at a site-level, not at the Trust-level. That means the data you provide should be broken down by individual sites - e.g. separate data for a hospital the trust manages, as well as a midwife-led unit.

Please indicate if a site is a midwife-led unit i.e. freestanding from a hospital.

Please provide this data for the latest five years for which it is available.

The data could be provided to me in the format of two tables, one for total number of claims and a second for the total value of damages. Each row would represent a site, and each column would be a year.

A1 Refer to the attached spread sheet, note: some of the data provided relates to legacy claims for Hospitals that no longer exist.

Please note that the (Freestanding Midwifery Unit) FMBU was suspended in 2020, and that no claims occurred at a freestanding midwifery unit in the claims listed
